



















Accomplishments

Basant Darbar

Formatting Tips:

- Between 10-12 point font
- Keep formatting on sections consistent
- Use headings and subheadings
- Proofread for spelling or grammatical errors
- Be consistent with verb tense either use past or present
- Stick to one page
- Always use bullet point
- Tailor your resume to the position you are applying for
